ARRIVING AT THE MUSEUM


FREE parking is available at the Wesley Bolin Plaza,

located east of the Museum, off Adams Street, before 17th Avenue. Buses may also drop off participants in the designated bus drop off zones on 17th Avenue in front of the Museum. FREE bus and additional parking is available in the Executive Tower parking lot east of 19th Avenue, between Jefferson and Washington Streets.

Please arrive 20 minutes prior to your performance time and wait outside at the Liberty Bell in front of the Museum. A staff member will meet and guide participants to the performance area. If you wish to arrive early and explore the Museum before your performance, please inform the Education Office by calling (602) 926-3810 or emailing MUSEUMTOURS@AZLEG.GOV at least 48 hours prior to arrival. ADDITIONAL PERFORMANCE TIME WILL NOT BE ALLOTTED FOR LATE ARRIVALS.

MUSEUM PERFORMANCE

Performances take place on the second floor of the Museum. Each choir performance is up to 45 minutes long and scheduled on the hour beginning at 10 a.m., with the last performance at 1 p.m. Please bring one chaperone per five to seven students. Chaperones



should stay with their assigned students at all times, to ensure students are considerate of other performers and visitors. **SEATING IS LIMITED**.

There is no designated area for eating inside the Museum and consuming food and beverage (except water) is not permitted on the upper floors of the Museum. If you plan to consume any food, please plan to eat outside of the Museum.

POST-PERFORMANCE

Students and chaperones are welcome to explore the Museum and Wesley Bolin Plaza. Maps are available at the Museum information desk on the 1st floor.

MUSEUM FREE EXPLORE: We invite and encourage exploration of areas and exhibits on the four floors of the Museum.
