Registration

Performances are up to 45 minutes long and scheduled on the hour beginning at 10 a.m., with the last performance at 1 p.m. Submit registration requests online at www.azcapitolmuseum.gov/choirs. Requests will be approved or denied via email.

Parking & Buses

Free parking is available at Wesley Bolin Plaza, located east of the Museum. Bus drivers may drop off visitors in front of the Museum in the designated bus drop off zones located on 17th Avenue. If 17th Avenue is closed, bus drivers may use Jefferson Street to drop off visitors near 17th Avenue. A parking map can be found [here](#) and on our website under the [Explore the Capitol](#) tab.

Arrival

Please arrive 20 minutes prior to your performance time and wait outside at the flag poles in front of the Museum. A staff member will greet and guide participants to the performance area. **Please note that additional performance time will not be granted to groups that arrive late.**

Personal Belongings, Food & Drink

We strongly discourage visitors from bringing backpacks, food or beverages into the Museum. Water is permitted in a closed container. There is no designated eating area inside the Museum. Food and drink (except water) is not permitted on the upper floors. Visitors may eat at the Wesley Bolin Plaza or on the legislative lawns when there are no events taking place. Trash receptacles are limited and we do not provide trash bag removal. Please plan to bring trash bags and be prepared to take all trash with you when leaving the Capitol grounds.

Chaperones

Please bring one chaperone per five to seven students. Chaperones should always stay with their assigned students and ensure students are considerate of other performers and visitors.

Equipment

A piano, PA system and auxiliary cable are available. Please bring a piano accompanist or pre-recorded accompaniment and a music stand if needed.

Seating

Seating is limited. Benches are available in the north and south hallways with very restricted views of the performance stage.

Post-Performance

Groups are welcome to explore the Museum and monuments and memorials in the Wesley Bolin Plaza. Maps are available at the information desk on the 1st floor. If you wish to arrive early or stay after your performance to explore the Museum, please inform the Education Office at least 48 hours prior to arrival.
